2010 Miss Village Creek Scholarship Pageant Rules

Ages 18 – 21

The Miss Village Creek Pageant is proud to announce that we are now a preliminary pageant for the Miss Texas International Pageant. Miss Village Creek will have the opportunity to advance to the state pageant with the winner from there advancing to the Miss International Pageant.

All contestants will be judged on overall appearance, eye contact, fashion, and stage presentation.

Rehearsal will be held on Wednesday, April 14, 2010 at 6:00 pm in the tent on the festival grounds. This is not a dress rehearsal but a time for me to go over how the pageant will be conducted. Everyone should be present. All contestants will receive one VIP parking pass for Friday night's pageant at the rehearsal. **Make sure you check in at rehearsal to receive your VIP Pass.** Contestants will be allowed to practice walking on the stage at the rehearsal.

On pageant night, contestants must check in between 7:00 - 7:30 pm. The pageant starts promptly at 8:00 pm. Only one parent may be present backstage.

If weather conditions are not favorable and the pageant needs to be moved, please provide us with a phone number on the application that you can be contacted at between 12:00 – 4:00 pm on the pageant day.

All participating contestants must be a permanent resident of Hardin County. Example: A contestant may currently be living in College Station attending A&M having graduated from a Hardin County high school with parents still living in Hardin County.

Young ladies must be between the ages of 18 – 21 on April 16, 2010.

Contestants must have never been married nor had a child.

One dress category only – Formal Pageant Dress

NO BARE MID-DRIFTS ALLOWED AND BRAS MUST BE WORN.

Unsportsmanship like conduct will not be tolerated.

Each contestant will be asked one of the three following questions on stage.

1. What is the best quality a parent could share with their child?
2. Who do you admire most, besides your mother and why?
3. What do you like most about living in Southeast Texas?

Contestants will be judged on stage presentation during this segment.

ALL CONTESTANTS SHOULD SUBMIT A PHOTO (A HEAD SHOT, SHOULDERS UP) TO THE CHAMBER BY MARCH 31, 2010. THIS PHOTO WILL BE USED TO DETERMINE THE PHOTOGENIC WINNER IN EACH CATEGORY. THE PHOTO WILL ALSO BE RAN IN THE HARDIN COUNTY NEWS AND THE SILSBEE BEE PRIOR TO THE PAGEANT. (THERE IS NO EXTRA CHARGE FOR BEING JUDGED IN THE PHOTOGENIC CATEGORY).

The contestant crowned Miss Village Creek in the pageant is expected to ride in the Lighted Night Time Christmas Parade in December. You will be mailed a registration form for the parade in November. You are responsible for providing your own candy to throw during the parade.

Miss Village Creek will receive a scholarship to the college of her choice. The scholarship will expire two years from date of issue. The entry fee for the state pageant includes the opening number gown, sash, meals and activities. The hotel, travel expenses and additional pageant wear are not included.

Deadline for entry is March 31, 2010.

All pageant rules must be complied with in order to prevent point deductions or possible disqualification.

Prizes

The winner of the Miss Village Creek Scholarship Pageant will receive a crown, a banner, a trophy, a dozen red roses, a \$500.00 scholarship to the college of her choice and a \$650.00 paid entry fee to the Miss Texas International Pageant.

1st runner-up will receive a trophy.

2nd runner-up will receive a trophy.

3rd runner-up will receive a trophy.

Photogenic winner will receive a trophy.

All other contestants will receive a participation trophy.
